

HJ Andrews Experimental Forest 60th Anniversary

The year 2008 marked two important anniversaries: the centennial of the Experimental Forests and Ranges (EFRs) and the 60th anniversary of one of the “crown jewels” of the EFRs — the H.J. Andrews Experimental Forest on the Willamette National Forest, Blue River, Oregon.

The HJ Andrews Experimental Forest and the Experimental Forests and Ranges have great histories of accomplishments in science and partnerships with management. Both are making important transformations to address the challenges posed by environmental change. Both are positioned to address questions at the continental scale by working across the networks of EFRs, Long-Term Ecological Research sites, and other research networks.
